Dear Parent or Guardian,

Congratulations to your future Celt! «First\_Name\_Legal» is registered for our Summer Transition Program (STP). STP is a tremendous opportunity for your student to get a jumpstart on their high school experience in an inviting and engaging way. The program runs from **Monday, June 25 – Friday, July 20**, excluding Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> in observance of Independence Day.

### **Daily Schedule**

Due to Transportation Department needs, the STP school day is from 7:40 AM – 12:10 PM each day. Buses arrive at 7:20 and depart at 12:45 to allow students time for breakfast and lunch (provided for free). Students will attend four courses daily: Reading, Writing, Math, and Careers. Each course will be one hour in length, and there will be a 15 minute break between Periods 2 and 3.

### **First Day**

Please arrive at McNary between 7:20 – 7:30 on Monday, June 25th. When students enter the front doors, there will be signs and friendly staff pointing them where to go for breakfast or to our auditorium for the STP opening meeting and to retrieve class schedules. Students are welcome to bring school supplies, but it is not necessary; STP will provide necessary learning materials for everyone. Students can just show up ready to learn, make friends, and get acquainted with their new campus!

### **Expectations**

Though this program is an extension of the school year, the behavioral and academic expectations of STP students is consistent with those of a typical McNary student. Upon satisfactory completion of STP, your student will receive 1.0 Elective credit, which is a requirement for high school graduation. In order to be eligible for credit, a student can be absent **no more than three (3)** school days. If an absence (vacation, illness, etc.) extends beyond the three-day absence limit, we still encourage your student to experience STP for the other positive results afforded.
